

A London town with an exciting future

Located 21 minutes by Tube from Euston Underground station, served by the Northern line, Colindale offers a fast commute into the City and further afield.

This corner of the popular London Borough of Barnet is steadily undergoing a full regeneration, benefitting from the £4.5 billion transformation of neighbouring Brent Cross and West Hendon.

A new school will be created within the Trinity Square development, adding to the great choice of schools and colleges nearby. London's leading universities are also within easy reach via Colindale Underground.

The best of London within easy reach

Ideal for commuters, Trinity Square is located just under a mile from both Colindale Underground station and Mill Hill Broadway rail station, connecting directly with the City in 22 minutes.

Venture to Central London, where Oxford Street and its multitude of shops can be reached within 45 minutes. If you're looking to escape London, the M1 is easily accessible by car. By Tube, Kings Cross Station is just 22 minutes from Colindale Underground and is a gateway to the north of the UK. Luton Airport is a convenient 25-minute journey from Mill Hill Broadway Station.

Great shopping and dining on your doorstep

The direct area offers a good selection of contemporary bars and restaurants, all within walking distance. In nearby Mill Hill Broadway and Edgware, you will find a number of independent boutiques, coffee shops and traditional pubs.

Pause for a coffee at Coffee Affair, your friendly little neighbourhood coffee shop, or try Sunny Hill Café – a hidden gem with a cosy log cabin interior. Or dine in one of the many nearby pubs and restaurants offering various cuisines from around the world.

The Beaufort Pub offers a sunny patio garden and traditional British dining

garden, Di Princi serves up hand-crafted Italian food 'just as Mamma cooked it!' With live jazz performances most Saturdays, Atithi offers delicious north Indian dishes and El-Valquero is a lively meat eater's paradise serving authentic South American food.

At nearby Brent Cross Shopping Centre, free all-day parking is offered alongside the choice of over 120 shops, bars and restaurants. A £1.4bn makeover will see the shopping centre double in size by 2021/2022. The plans include a new cinema complex, hotel and over 200 extra retail brands.





Popular places to explore

Fill your weekends visiting some of the other local attractions. The RAF Museum is located just down the road or Harry Potter World at Warner Bros. Studio is a short car journey away.

Green open spaces are in abundance, with over 200 parks and open spaces to explore across the Borough of Barnet. Mill Hill Park is just 15 minutes' walk away or there's Aldenham Country Park boasting 160 acres of open space.

Golf courses, running tracks and sailing at the nearby Welsh Harp Brent Reservoir are all around a ten-minute drive or just a couple of stops on the Tube.

Sports facilities are excellent with several leisure centres to choose from nearby. Book a tee time at Bushey Hall Golf Course, an 18-hole course open to the public as well as members with a clubhouse that has stood for over a century. The Copthall Leisure Centre sits in the Allianz Park stadium and is home to The Tom Daly Diving Academy.


